



The Canoe Ashe Map displays roads maintained by the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) only.

This map displays all NCDOT and private bridges as of February 2024. All low water bridges are subject to requiring portage. It is recommended that all low water bridges are portaged.

River trip durations and distances can vary greatly with stream levels. For stream gage heights, visit the USGS South Fork New River Near Jefferson, NC - 03161000 monitoring location for daily streamflow conditions. <https://waterdata.usgs.gov/nc/nwis/rt> Please note that the New River flows from South to North.
